



AUTOMATIC AVAILABILITY OF CERTAIN RECORDS OF THE NATIONAL GAMBLING BOARD


Section 15 of the Promotion of Access to Information Act, 2000 (Act 2 of 2000) (as amended)

And

Regulation 4 of the Regulations relating to the Promotion of Access to Information, 2021

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The National Gambling Board (“NGB”) is a statutory body established in terms of the National Gambling Act, 2004 (Act 7 of 2004) (“NGA”) to provide for the coordination of concurrent national and provincial legislative competence over matters relating to casinos, racing, gambling and wagering, and provide for the continued regulation of those matters.
- 1.2. As an organ of state and registered as a Schedule 3A public entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act 1 of 1999) (“PFMA”), the NGB is obligated to comply with provisions of applicable legislation.
- 1.3. Section 15 of the Promotion of Access to Information Act, 2000 (Act 2 of 2000) stipulates that an Information Officer of a public body must make available in the prescribed manner a description of the categories of records of the public body that are automatically available without a person having to request access in terms of PAIA, including such categories available for inspection in terms of legislation other than PAIA, for purchase or copying from the public body, from the public body free of charge and how to obtain access to such records.
- 1.4. Regulation 4 of the Regulations relating to the Promotion of Access to Information, 2021 stipulates that the Information Officer of a public body, must compile and keep a description of the categories of records contemplated in section 15 (1) (a) of PAIA, that are automatically available without a requester having a request access thereto.
- 1.5. A requester may request a copy of a record referred to in section 15 of PAIA, read with Regulation 4 of the Regulations relating to the Promotion of Access to Information, 2021 and must be provided with such copy, upon payment of the fee for reproduction, as provided for in items 2 to 8 of Annexure B of Regulations relating to Promotion of Access to Information, 2021.
- 1.6. In compliance with the statutory requirements of the PAIA and to contribute to the promotion of transparency, accountability and effective governance, the NGB has produced a category of records that are automatically available without having to request access in terms of the PAIA. Other records maintained by the NGB must be requested in terms of the procedures outlined in the PAIA Manual.
